Advanced Placement (AP)

Description

College Board's Advanced Placement or AP exams test on specific subjects taken at the end of AP courses offered at high schools. According to the College Board, AP exams are subject-based standardized tests that assess students' understanding of the material taught in high school AP courses. AP exams occur annually in May and are offered in nearly 40 subject areas covering English, mathematics, sciences, history/social sciences, the arts, and world languages.

AP exam scores range from 1 (lowest) to 5 (highest).

4	Well Qualified
3	Qualified
2	Possibly Qualified
1	No Recommendation
